REPORT ON A TRIP TO THE TIRTHAN VALLEY, GREAT HIMALAYAN NATIONAL PARK, HIMACHAL PRADESH, NORTHWEST INDIA, WITH LATER TRIP TOWARDS ROTHANG PASS 13 April, 2003 to 25 April, 2003

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Sun 13/4 Flew Delhi-Kullu on Jagson Airlines. Met by Harkirat Sangha at Kullu Airport. Drove to Sai Ropa Tourist Centre.

Mon 14/4 early am birded around Sai Ropa; then drove to Gushaini. Walked from Gushaini to Rolla along Tirthan River; late pm walked up south-facing slope ca.1km before Rolla, on path that leads up from opposite remaining farm.

Tues 15/4 walked from Rolla (1963m) to Shilt (2900m) up very steep track. Narrow zigzag up 40 degree slope made for very tough going. Porters said that a week earlier, two Americans had tried and given up half way. Late pm around Shilt.

Wed 16/4 overcast with showers; cleared late pm. started 5.45 am on track northeast to Chhoa Dar, back 9.30. 11.00-12.30 on track to south at rock marked T1/46 below Silth to rhododendron meadows. Afternoon up steep slope to ridge behind Silth, walked along ridge then down to join track at T1/46. Late pm walked part of track to Chhoa Dar again. Thurs 17/4 am walked down to Ghranel at 2600m. Late pm walked trail to Chhoa Dar again.

Fri 18/4 early around Shilt. 10am walked down from Shilt to Rolla. Late pm. again up south-facing slope above remaining farm in search of Cheer Pheasants.

Sat 19/4 heavy rain until ca. 2.30 pm walked up to Khorli Poi at ca.3000m. Very unpleasent walking. Bigger zigzags in track, but much of track dug up by brown bears in search of roots.

Sun 20/4 ca 6 cm of snow overnight, and few birds as a result. Walked below camp then picked up track back to camp.

Mon 21/4 walked up to Chanam Pass reached ca 3500m on rockfall. Pass deep in ice and snow. Evening walk near camp.

Tues 22/4 rose at 5 am in hopes of seeing Western Tragopan near camp. Left to walk down to Rolla at 9.15 am and arrived 12.15pm. Late pm walked up south-facing slope above farm.

Wed 23/4 left Rolla 9.15 am for walk back to Gushaini then back to Sai Ropa.

Thurs 24/4 early around Sai Ropa then drove to Manali and stayed at Johnson House. Ca. 3 pm drove towards Rothang Pass. Road blocked by police ca 2 km past Gulaba.

Thousands of people and many stalls. Walked up about 3.5 km.

Fri 25/4 started 5.45 am to beat police road block. Drove to ca 3500m where road blocked by river. Pass still with deep snow and ice.

4pm walked Manali Nature Trail.

Startled. started to walk up slope then turned and flew rapidly down slope. Good views for 4-5 sec. Second male flew down behind that one but kept going down slope. late pm 1 female flushed along track. All brownish. Tragopans most vocal in overcast weather.

17/4 Shilt: 1 tragopan called 5.15 pm for about 4 mins and another soon after. A third bird called at 6.15pm.

21/4 Khorli Poi. 1 tragopan called near camp 15 times at 3.45 am. 2 birds calling shortly after dawn. I bird possibly had territory uphill and left from meadow.

22/4 1 bird called sporadically during night.

Koklass Pheasant Pucrasia macrolopha

The birds would flush immediately they detected you, and I strongly suspect that they are still being shot or trapped. Birds around Khorli Poi were a little less skittish. For example, I saw a female run away from me en route to Chanam Pass on 21/4. Finally got an excellent look at a male at 5.30 am in the opening at Khorli Poi.
